

Updated Entry Regulations for Entrants coming from the United Kingdom/South Africa

Background

To prevent the spread of the new Covid19 variant, South Korea has strengthened anti-infection measures.

Updates

- All flights from the United Kingdom have been halted until January 7, 2021.
- The South Korean Embassy in London and Pretoria will NOT issue Isolation exemption certificates until January 17, 2021.
- **Effective from December 29, 2020 (local time in London and Pretoria), the South Korean Embassy in London and Pretoria will NOT issue new VISAs until further notice. Those who have a valid VIN are also NOT allowed to get VISA from these two Embassies.**
- All entrants coming from the United Kingdom and South Africa, including those who depart from these two countries and take a transit flight in a 3rd country before arriving in South Korea:
 - 1) are required to submit their negative Covid19 test result certificate upon arrival in South Korea. Medical test requirements will be updated on the respective Embassies' websites by December 31, 2020.
 - 2) are required to get another PCR test prior to the end of their 2 weeks quarantine period in South Korea.

Exceptions

Official/Diplomat passport holders and those coming for humanitarian purpose (E.g. Attending family's funeral) can get their VISAs from the Korean Embassy in London and/or Pretoria.
